CONTRACT RENEWAL between State of Florida and United Healthcare of Florida, Inc. State Contract No.: DMS 10/11-011 HMO SERVICES

This Renewal, effective January 1, 2014, is between the State of Florida, Department of Management Services (Department), Division of State Group Insurance (Division), an agency of the State of Florida with offices at 4050 Espianade Way, Taliahassee, Florida 32399-0950, and United Healthcare of Florida, Inc. (Service Provider), a corporation registered to do business in Florida, and renews State Contract No.: DMS 10/11-011 HMO Services.

Whereas, the Department awarded Contract No. DMS 10/11-011 to Service Provider, United Healthcare of Florida, Inc., for the provision of HMO Services, pursuant to section 110.123, Florida Statutes.

Now therefore, in consideration of the mutual promises contained in the Contract, the parties agree to the following:

1. CONTRACT RENEWAL TERM.

The parties entered into a Contract for an Initial term of two (2) years which term ends December 31, 2013. Pursuant to Section 2.1.2 of the Contract, the State of Florida hereby exercises its right to renew. The Parties hereby agree to a renewal of the contract for a period of two (2) years to expire at midnight on December 31, 2015.

2. ASO FEES.

Monthly Administrative Service Only (ASO) feet for calendar years 2014 and 2015 will be \$ per employee per month (PEPM) for Standard Plan and \$ PEPM for Health Investor Health Plan.

3. E-VERIFY.

Pursuant to State of Florida Executive Orders Nos.; 11-02 and 11-116, Service Provider is required to utilize the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify system to verify the employment of all new amployees hired by the Service Provider during the contract term. Also, Service Provider shall include in related subcontracts a requirement that subcontractor performing work or providing services pursuant to the state contract utilize the E-Verify system to verify employment of all new employees hired by the subcontractor during the contract term.

4. SCRUTINIZED COMPANIES.

In executing this contract, Service Provider certifies that it is not listed on either the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in the Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List, created pursuant to section 215.473, Florida Statutes. Pursuant to section 287.135(5), Florida Statutes, Service Provider agrees the Department may immediately terminate this contract for cause if the Service Provider is found to have submitted a false certification or if Service Provider is placed on the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in Sudan List or the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in the Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List during the term of the contract.

5. WARRANT OF AUTHORITY.

Each person signing this Amendment warrants that he or she is duly authorized to do so and to bind the respective party.

6. EFFECT.

Unless otherwise modified by this Renewal, all terms and conditions contained in the Contract shall continue in full force and effect.
