# CONTRACT NO.: DMS-14/15-018 BETWEEN FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT SERVICES AND SUN LIFE ASSURANCE COMPANY OF CANADA

**AMENDMENT NO.: 8** 

This Amendment to Contract No.: DMS-14/15-018 (the "Contract") is by and between the State of Florida acting through the Department of Management Services (the "Department") and Sun Life Assurance Company of Canada ("Service Provider" or "Vendor"), collectively known as the "Parties."

Therefore, the Parties do hereby agree to amend the Contract as follows:

- 1. Extension Term. The Department hereby extends the Contract until December 31, 2021. This Contract Extension will be in effect with no plan or premium changes for or during the Contract Extension Term.
- 2. Premium Rates. The monthly premium rates during the Extension Term remain unchanged from the Contract.
- 3. Section 5.2.6, E-Verify, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

## 5.2.6 E-Verify

The Vendor (and its subcontractors) have an obligation to utilize the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) E-Verify system for all newly hired employees. By executing this Contract, the Vendor certifies that it is registered with, and uses, the E-Verify system for all newly hired employees. The Vendor must obtain an affidavit from its subcontractors in accordance with paragraph (2)(b) of section 448.095, Florida Statutes, and maintain a copy of such affidavit for the duration of the Contract. In order to implement this provision, the Vendor shall provide a copy of its DHS Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to the Contract Manager within five (5) days of Contract execution.

This section serves as notice to the Vendor regarding the requirements of section 448.095, Florida Statutes, specifically sub-paragraph (2)(c)1, and the Department's obligation to terminate the Contract if it has a good faith belief that the Vendor has knowingly violated section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes. If terminated for such reason, the Vendor will not be eligible for award of a public contract for at least one year after the date of such termination. The Department reserves the right to order the immediate termination of any contract between the Vendor and a subcontractor performing work on its behalf should the Department develop a good faith belief that the subcontractor has knowingly violated section 448.095(1), Florida Statutes.

- 4. This Amendment is hereby made a part of the Contract. All other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect. Except as otherwise expressly set forth herein, the terms and conditions contained in the Contract and subsequent amendments are unchanged. This Amendment sets forth the entire understanding between the Parties with regard to the subject matter hereof.
- 5. This Amendment is effective January 1, 2021 or on the last date of execution, whichever is later.
