

# **CERTIFICATION CHECKLIST**

Florida's Office of Supplier Development (OSD) certifies woman-, veteran-, and minority-owned small businesses for FREE.

#### Certification is simple and offers the following benefits:

- Referrals to state agencies and other organizations seeking certified businesses
- A listing as a certified business in the State of Florida's eProcurement system
- Customized communication on networking events and technical assistance
- Free online recertification every two years

### MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Your business must meet the following minimum eligibility requirements to become a certified woman business enterprise (WBE), veteran business enterprise (VBE), or minority business enterprise (MBE):

- Be legally registered to do business in Florida as a for-profit organization (registration through the Department of State's Sunbiz.org)
   Be based and domiciled in Florida
- Be owned and managed by a permanent resident(s) of Florida
- Be 51% owned and managed by a woman, veteran, or minority who is a U.S citizen or a permanent resident alien
- Be engaged in commercial transactions (currently doing business)
- · Have a net worth of less than \$5 million
- Have 200 or fewer full-time permanent employees
- Have a professional license, if required by the industry, in the name of the woman, veteran, or minority business owner
- Be registered in MyFloridaMarketPlace (MFMP)

#### **CERTIFICATION PROCESS**

If you meet the minimum eligibility requirements above, you are ready to start the certification process by following these steps:



Step 1: Register as a vendor on <u>vendor.myfloridamarketplace.com</u>
Log in and locate the certification application at the
bottom of the "Company Information" tab in your MFMP



Step 2: Review the Required Documentation List and gather the necessary documentation.



Step 3: Upload and submit your certification documents in your MFMP account for review by OSD.

## **DOCUMENTATION CHECKLIST**

Before submitting your documents to OSD, use this certification checklist to ensure you have the documents required for certification. OSD cannot review your application until all supporting documents are received.

Documents must be current (not expired). Redact any personal identifying information.

## **VETERAN CERTIFICATION**

For veteran (VBE) certification, submit ALL of the following documents:
