Important News About Electing Your Beneficiary for Life Insurance:

Minnesota Life Insurance Company will be the new carrier for Life Insurance effective January 1, 2008. All benefits remain the same. However, you must submit a Beneficiary Designation either online or by submitting a form to Minnesota Life.

Did You Know?

- You can update your beneficiary information directly by logging on to www.lifebenefits.com/florida
- If you do not have your People First Employee ID number, you will not be able to designate a beneficiary on the Minnesota Life website. You will need to mail a beneficiary form (available on the People First website) to Minnesota Life.
- Your current coverage will transfer to Minnesota Life automatically. Any previously held life insurance beneficiary designation will NOT transfer to Minnesota Life.

How Do I Designate A Beneficiary?

- 1. Logon to the Minnesota Life website at www.lifebenefits.com/florida
- 2. Enter FL then your People First Employee ID number
- 3. Enter your date of birth
- 4. Enter the last four digits of you social security number **NOTE**: To request a Beneficiary Designation form you can call the People First Service Center at 1-866-663-4735 or complete the Beneficiary Designation form located on the People First web site.

What If I Do Not Designate A Beneficiary?

If you do not designate a beneficiary with Minnesota Life, your beneficiary will be the default beneficiary as stated in the policy. In the event of your death, subsequent to designating a beneficiary, benefits will be paid in the following order:

- 1. Your lawful spouse, if living.
- 2. Your natural or legally adopted child (children) in equal shares, if living.
- 3. Your parents, in equal shares, if living.
- 4. The personal representative of your estate.
