Congratulations on your new position with the State of Florida! You now have access to the state's online personnel system, People First. In People First you can maintain your direct deposit, W-4, and personal information; and, if applicable, you can complete your timesheet and enroll in health and insurance benefits.

To log on to your People First user account, go to the secure People First website at <u>https://PeopleFirst.MyFlorida.com</u>.

- You will need your People First user ID number, shown above.
- The first time you log on, your temporary password will be pf, your two-digit birth month, two-digit birth date, and the last two digits of your birth year. For example, if you were born on March 5, 1972, your password would be pf030572.
- Once you've entered your user ID and temporary password, the system will ask you to choose three security questions and answers, as well as change your password. Be sure to remember your security answers and password. Instructions and password guidelines are on the People First website.
